This 44,000 SqFt free-standing structure for the Charlotte Mecklenburg School System offered two stories of new science labs and classrooms. Considerable coordination took place with on-site school administration to ensure that classes currently in session weren't disrupted. Before construction of the building could commence, grading and paving for a two acre parking lot to support traffic for the site was required. There were intense mechanical needs for the new building to accommodate the lab's gas and acid waste lines, fume control, etc. Hendrick provided all lockers and coordinated manufacturing and installation of the science casework which contained integrated mechanical systems. The pitched roof structure was built-up asphalt. This project took twelve months to complete.
