JACOBSEN TEXTRON

This project was the renovation of a 200,000 square foot facility for Jacobsen-Texttron. It included the demolition of over 12,000 square feet of office space, the addition of 8,300 square feet of elevated steel and concrete mezzanine as well as 21,000 square feet of new office space. Additional work space and tear down areas were also installed for training and demonstration purposes. Two new loading docks with levelers were added to accommodate the increased shipping requirements of our client. Along with re-roofing the entire facility, a new twelve unit HVAC system had to be installed. In order to comply with local fire code, a larger pump room with fire suppression pump had to be installed along with an explosion proof oil storage room to house combustible materials. An updated training room/break room was also included to provide a comfortable learning environ-
