This project consisted of a 7,000 square foot addition to an existing sanctuary. Construction included a common community gathering area and large worship area with high vaulted ceilings and extensive sound and lighting system. The design of the ceiling in the narthex had to be modified in the field to obtain the appropriate ceiling heights. The structural steel was ordered, fabricated and installed in three days so that the project remained on schedule. New construction components were architecturally designed to match with the existing structure. Existing mechanical, electrical and plumbing services were upgraded to accommodate the newly expanded areas. The multi-faceted existing roof line was modified to provide pitch of rain water away from the new structures.
